by Gaël Le Neillon

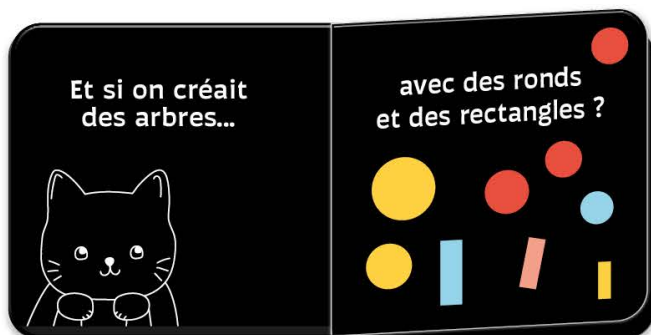
A boardbook that plays with shapes and colors to help toddlers discover their creative potential!

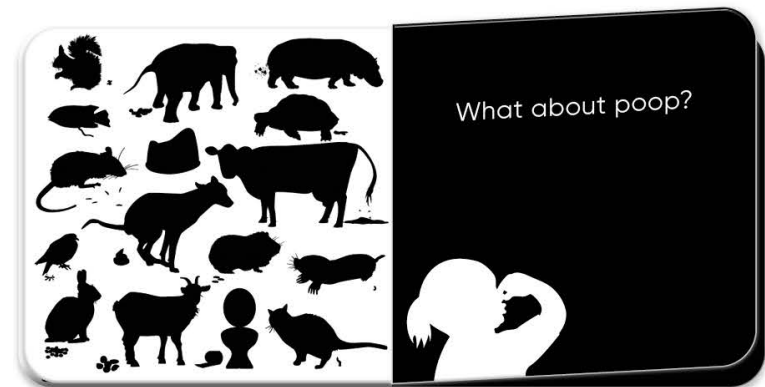


## Five Senses in Pictures

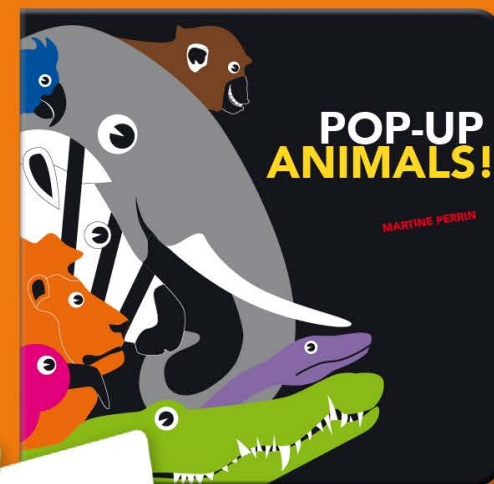


# Pop-up Animals!

# My First Big Wordbook

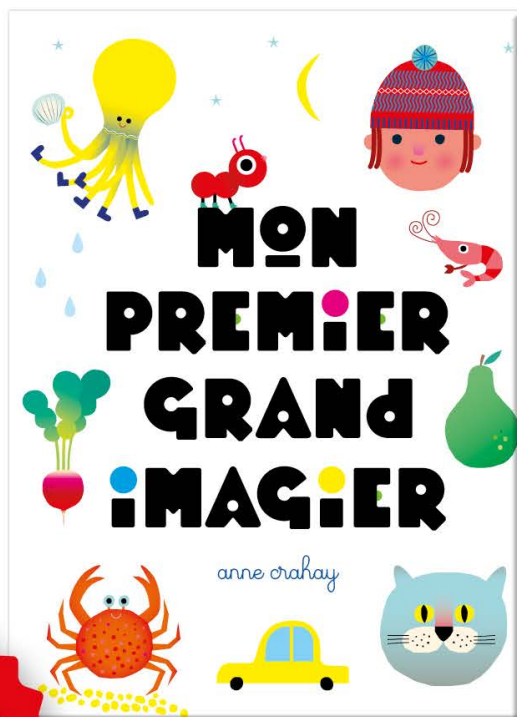

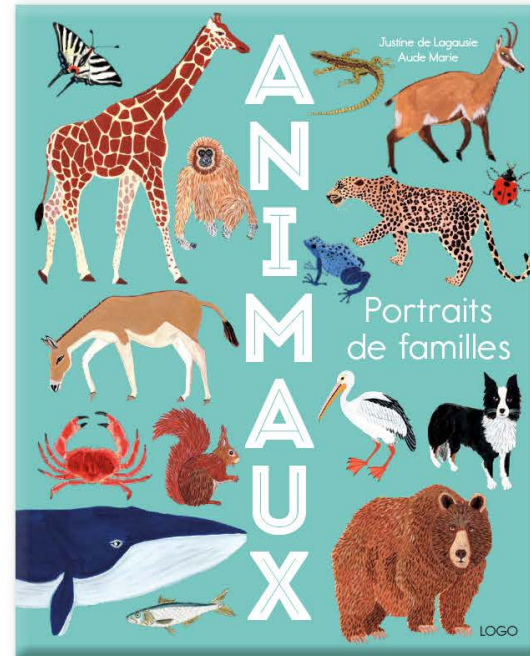
# Animals - Family Portraits

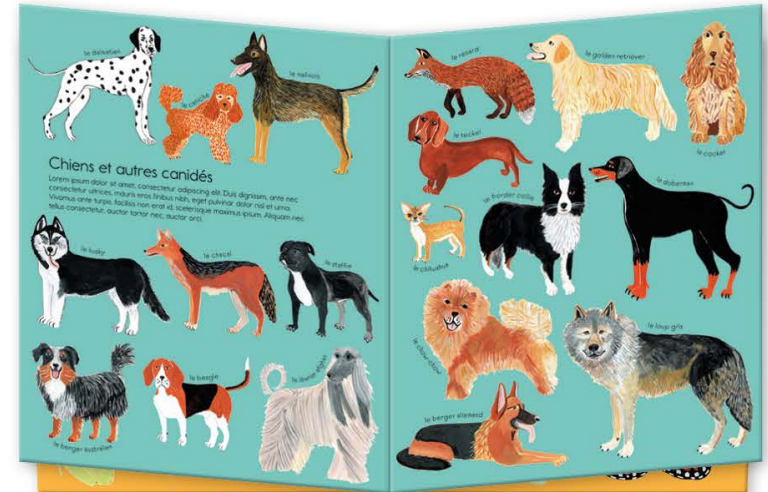
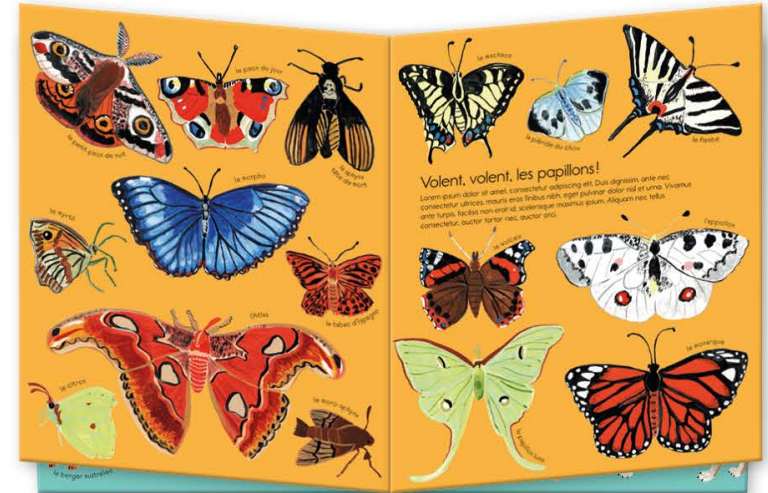

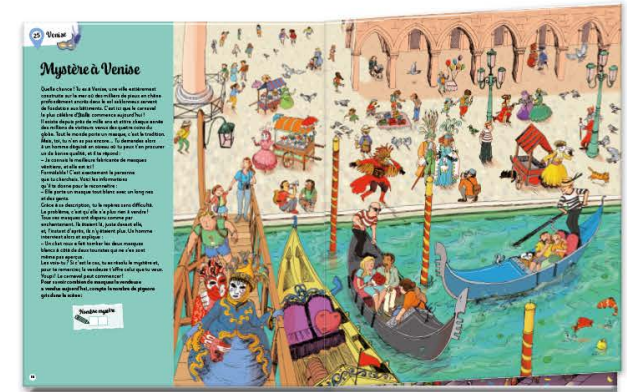
